Maintenance Work at Civic Centre, Station Road

Work on the retaining wall of the Civic Centre in Station Road commenced on Monday 7th February. Temporary traffic lights are to be in use while work is carried out, expected to take several weeks, and are scheduled to be removed on 6th March.

The maintenance work will include the removal and rebuilding of the lower section of the wall and reducing the bank's steep angle. "Disruption to traffic will be kept to a minimum while these repairs are carried out," said Councillor Sue Doyle.

Originally a school, the Civic Centre has been used as a community facility for the past thirty years and is run by Wootton Bassett Town Council. The building has two floors available to clubs and organisations to use rooms on a regular basis, as well as being let out for parties and meetings. Each room has tables and chairs that can be used and a spacious and fully equipped kitchen, making it convenient for meetings and functions.

Councillors are resolved to ensuring all essential maintenance work is carried out while a new community centre is sought.
